 - e. A Pre-Authorization Access Form to facilitate access for you and your spouse (if applicable) on to the Base. If you do not have a driver's license, information will be required for you and whoever will be bringing you to and from our Museum. This form will be used if necessary by Security to perform a mandatory background check and subsequent issuance of a Defense Biometric Identification System (DBIDS) access card. A valid driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of vehicular insurance will be required to complete the DBIDS card issuance process.
4. Diagrams showing our Special Assistants and Functional Teams and brochures and information about our Museum.

Volunteer applications are reviewed by our functional Team Chiefs at regularly scheduled staff meetings to insure we can blend your interests and skills with our needs. Our next staff meetings are scheduled for 19 August, 21 October, and 16 December 2016. You will be advised of our decisions and provided with further information shortly thereafter.
