

# *F-16A “Fighting Falcon”*



## *Adopted by Boy Scout Troop 200*

The F-16 was the result of a request by the US Air Force for a light-weight, low-cost, high-performance aircraft. This General Dynamics built F-16A aircraft was flown by two Selfridge units, 191<sup>st</sup> Fighter Interceptor Group (FIG) from 1990 to 1994 and the 127<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing (FW) from 1990 to 2009. In 1994, the 191<sup>st</sup> FIG converted to the C-130 Hercules and in 2009, the 127<sup>th</sup> FW converted to the A-10 Thunderbolt II.
