

## ***T6 “Texan”***



### ***Adopted by The Fountain Family***

The T-6 “Texan” was flown by all three flying squadrons in the Michigan ANG from 1946 to 1955. This aircraft was originally a Marine Corps SNJ-4, serial number 27842. It was last stationed at MCAS Cherry Point, NC in the 1950s. It was declared excess and went through a number of private organizations, purchased by the Selfridge Military Air Museum in 2013 and restored by the Museum’s volunteer restoration team to represent a T-6 flown by the Michigan ANG’s 171<sup>st</sup> FBS from 1953 to 1955.
